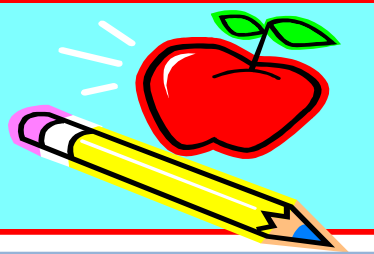

The dog's ability to calm autistic children gives the child an increased attention span and a greater aptitude for learning. The service dogs act as an anchor when the child is tethered to the dog. Having a service dog can create freedom for the child and family to go outside of the house safely and confidently, which expands a child's capabilities to experience more of life and to grow, improving a child's socialization and behavior skills.
